RECOMMENDATION:

That the road heading west off Hotston Road, Black Mountain be named Lorna Drive, subject to no objections being received following the public notification between 12 – 26 October 2016.

Introduction:

The road servicing the new subdivision was originally proposed to be named Martin Drive, but this name was subsequently disallowed by the Geographical Names Board because there is a Martin Street in Armidale.

Report:

The road services a subdivision of some 18 lots and runs off Hotston Road. There is a short cul de sac that runs off the new road that has previously been named Elaine Close. The developer has suggested an alternative name of Lorna Drive to replace the previously suggested Martin Drive. This name is associated with one of the original settlers of Black Mountain.

Community Engagement and Internal Consultation

The name is suggested by the developers who are residents of the Black Mountain area. The community have the opportunity to lodge an objection to the name during the public exhibition period.
