

## Application for Bushfire Attack Level (BAL) Certificate for New Dwelling houses and Alterations and Additions to Dwelling houses

### 1. Information

The Codes SEPP has been amended so that land identified as being bush fire prone is no longer listed as a land exemption and is no longer excluded from the application of one or more codes. Instead, specified development requirements and development standards have been added to the General Housing Code and the Rural Housing Code that apply to new development undertaken on low risk bush fire prone land.
