1. Award Categories

You may only nominate one person or an organisation per form from the Armidale Regional Council Local Government Area for one of the following awards. Please tick the relevant award.

You may nominate one person or an organisation for one category only per form.

Guyra* Citizen of the Year

This award recognises an outstanding member of the community for their personal endeavours and contribution to the community or to a group within the community. For example:

- How has the nominee made a significant contribution to the community or to a group within the community?
- How have these contributions been of benefit to a range of people within the community?

Guyra* Young Citizen of the Year (under 25 years on 26 January 2020)

This award recognises an outstanding young member of the community for their personal contribution to the community. For example:

- How has the nominee been a positive role model for younger people in the community?
- How has the community benefited from the activities of the nominee?

Guyra*Community Service Award for a group or club

This award recognises a group / club or organisation that through the efforts of the members has made a significant contribution to the community. For example:

- How have the activities of the group been of benefit to the community?
- How has the group, club or organisation raised the profile of the community?

Guyra* Sportsperson of the Year

This award recognises a person who has excelled in their chosen sport and through their participation has inspired and encouraged others. For example:

- What personal bests have been achieved or sports awards won?
- How does the nominee demonstrate good sportsmanship?

Guyra*Contribution to Sports and Recreation

This award recognises an individual or group who, through their efforts, have made a contribution to the advancement of sport or recreation within the community. For example:

- What have been the contributions of the person or group to the advancement of sport or participation of sports?
- How has this been beneficial to the community?

Guyra*Art and Culture Award

This award recognises an individual or group who have made a significant contribution to the advancement of art and culture in the community. For example:

- How has the nominee brought or promoted art and culture to the broader community?
- How has the nominee developed a stronger community through art and cultural activities?

Guyra*Community Event of the Year (The event must be completed in 2019) This award recognises an event or festival that has been conducted within the Local Government Area that has contributed to social harmony and an inclusive community. For example:

- How has the event strengthened the community spirit?
- How well did the organisers involve and work in collaboration with community groups to showcase the area?

Guyra* Environmental Citizen of the Year.

This award is for individuals or organisations championing environmental initiatives in the community. For example:

- How have they contributed to the preservation of the environment?
- How have they been building partnerships to achieve litter reduction, recycling or regeneration projects?

- The awards will be specific to Guyra* and district.
- Please fill in as much information as possible, nominations will not be accepted if they do not include enough information to process the nomination.
- Please print clearly in blue or black pen.
- Nominees must be residents of the Armidale Regional Council Local Government Area.
