Armidale Regional Council is proudly supporting the local waste > art & design competition 2019.

The waste > art & design competition provides an opportunity for all residents in the Armidale Regional Council area to communicate the waste reduction message and to showcase their artistic and creative talents.

Entries will be accepted on Wednesday 29 May and Thursday 30 May 2019, venue to be confirmed.

Armidale Regional Council will provide vouchers for the winners in each of the competition categories.

An exhibition of the works will be held in an empty shop in the central mall area from 3 – 8 June 2019.

Entry is FREE so think creatively and start planning your art work now!

Competition Categories

SECTION 1 – Pre School Age

There is no theme in this category. Entries must use recyclable and/or reused materials.

SECTION 2 – Primary Schools

Entries must be submitted as a Class entry (ie Year 2B, 4C) and use recyclable and/or reused materials. Entries can be in any form: 2D/3D/Photographic. This year's Primary School theme is **Beat Plastic Pollution**. If you can't reuse it, don't use it. Take the pledge to beat plastic pollution. What simple things can you do to reduce single use plastic?

SECTION 3 – Secondary Schools

This year's Secondary Section has a theme of **7 Billion Dreams. One Planet. Consume with Care**. Living within planetary boundaries is the most promising strategy for ensuring a healthy future. Human prosperity need not cost the earth. Living sustainably is about doing more and better with less. Entries are to incorporate items that would be considered old, unwanted, defunct or reusable. Entries can be in any form: 2D/3D/Photographic.

SECTION 4 – UNE Students

There is no specific theme in this category. Entries must use recyclable and/or reused materials and can either communicate a message about waste reduction or be submitted solely for their creative and artistic merit. Entries can be in any form: 2D/3D/Photographic.

SECTION 5 – Open Community

There is no specific theme in this category. Entries must use recyclable and/or reused materials and can either communicate a message about waste reduction or be submitted solely for their creative and artistic merit.

- Art (2D/3D/Sculpture)
- Functional Art (Furniture/Inventions/Homewares)
- Textiles and Wearable Art (Clothing/Jewellery)
- Building or Elements of Building or Large Sculpture (Photographic entries only)
- Junior Section – 7-16yrs (entries can be in any form: 2D/3D/Sculpture)

SECTION 6 – People's Choice Award

Visitors to the exhibition will be given the opportunity to vote for their choice of overall winner across all categories. Voting cards will be collected at the end of the exhibition period.

Conditions of entry

Entrants must reside in the Armidale Regional Council area.

Entrants may only submit one entry in each category.

The entry must be the original work of the artist/s.

All entries must incorporate the re-use or recycling of waste or pre/loved materials.

The item cannot have previously been entered in a Waste > Art competition.

Each entry must be no larger than 1m² x 1.5m² and should weigh no more than 15kg. If the artwork does not meet these criteria, the artist's entry can only be submitted as a photographic entry with a detailed explanation allowed.

Any wall hangings must come complete with a hanging mechanism. Council WILL NOT do this for you.

All photographic entries are to be printed by the artist and submitted in a manageable display frame with a hanging mechanism.

All artworks MUST BE clearly labeled with the entrant's name & artwork name upon delivery to Council.

The Council is not responsible for any loss or damage that may occur to entries. However, reasonable care will be applied in dealing with the entries submitted.

All artworks remain the property of the entrant and must be collected immediately after the exhibition closes.

Audio Visual entries are to be no longer in duration than 5 minutes and are to be provided either on CD/DVD or USB stick (please check they work before submitting your entry).

Competition coordinators reserve the right to amend the entry category specified by the entrant if it is deemed to be incorrect.

Winning entrants in the School sections will win prizes on behalf of their school.

Competition coordinators reserve the right to reject inappropriate artworks as deemed by them.

By completing and submitting an entry form, the entrant confirms that they have read the terms and conditions and agree to participate in accordance with these. The entrant also agrees that their artwork may be photographed and used in any promotional materials now or in the future and at the discretion of Armidale Regional Council.

Entries are to be delivered to the exhibition venue (details to be confirmed) on Wednesday 29 May 3pm to 5pm or Thursday 30 May between 10am to 12pm.
