

things to do on foot, bus and bike

- 1. Guided Heritage Tour. A leisurely 2½-hour city bus tour with a lively and personal commentary from one of our tour guides. The bus departs 10.00am Monday–Saturday (excluding Public Holidays) from the Visitor Information Centre. Bookings essential.
- 2. **Self-guided Heritage Walk.** Explore the heritage buildings, cathedrals, churches and the city of Armidale.
- 3. **New England Foodie Trail**. A beer, wine, cheese and local produce tour showcasing the best the New England has to offer. Bookings essential, phone 02 6778 4889.
- 4. Riding the Highs Motorcycle Tours. Experience the thrill of touring the New England High Country on a Harley-Davidson motorbike. Caters for all ages. Contact Bill on 0403 192 211.
- 5. **Hire a Bike**. Explore the city of Armidale or experience the thrill of mountain biking. Maps and details available from the Visitor Information Centre. There is also the option of a Hire Car.
- 6. **Museums.** The New England Regional Art Museum and the Aboriginal Cultural Centre and Keeping Place are located 1.5km (approximately 20-minute walk) from the Visitor Information Centre. The Armidale Folk Museum is located in the centre of town. Town buses service this area.
- 7. Art Galleries. The Armidale Art Gallery and Gallery 126 showcase local and visiting artists. The Armidale Art gallery is located in Beardy Street Mall and Gallery 126 on Jessie Street, a short 10-minute walk.
- 8. University of New England. Catch a bus to UNE and visit the Zoology Museum, Museum of Antiquities and have lunch at Booloominbah.
- 9. **Biodiversity Walk.** Walk or pedal the Dumaresq Creek track and discover some of the New England's amazing diversity. Information booklet available at the Visitor Information Centre.
- 10. Boutique Shopping. Take a stroll around Armidale and discover a wonderful range of boutiques. The weekend markets are where you will find an extensive selection of locally produced products, local arts and crafts.
